

Parliamentary Procedure Speaking Options

Introduction:

- *Name
- *Delegation
- *Representing [Country]
- *Thank you, Sir/Madam Chair

Regular Speech:
Give a speech for no more than 2 minutes

"I yield the remainder of my time to the chair."

Motion:
"I reserve my right to make a motion."

Give a speech for as long a desired (up to 2 to minutes).

I motion to:
*End/extend resolution debate
*Hear resolution on the floor authored by (authoring countries)
*Hear amendment on the floor authored by (authoring countries)

Question:
"Will the author(s) yield to a series of questions? I reserve my right to speak thereafter." (Must reserve right to speak thereafter if wishing to make remarks with remaining time after questioning.)

Ask author questions about the resolution.

Make any remarks that are not questions with remaining time.

"I yield the remainder of my time to the chair."

Yielding:
1) "I reserve my right to yield time to a fellow delegate."
OR
2) "I reserve my right to yield time to the author(s) summation."

Give a speech for at least 1 minute.

"I yield the remainder of my time to [fellow delegate or author's summation.]"
